If you need help with reading this book ask your Foster carers or Social worker or someone you trust.



You are in a home with carers who work with Jay Fostering. They will provide you with a safe and secure home.

You will be shown around the house and you can tell your carer how you would like your room to look.

Your foster carer will celebrate special occasions with you, and provide presents.

We want you to do well at school and will help you, just ask. We will also help you to join clubs or activities you wish to take part in.

We will visit and talk to you. Tell us if you are happy or sad about anything we will listen to you.



Jay Fostering has to make sure that you are happy and feel that everyone is keeping to the rules. If you are unhappy tell a person from Jay Fostering, your social worker or your foster carer.

Nobody will be angry with you



If you are unhappy at the way you are treated then Jay Fostering will talk to people and try to make things fairer for you.

We will write everything down so we can remember and then show you. If you still feel that things are unfair then tell us about it.



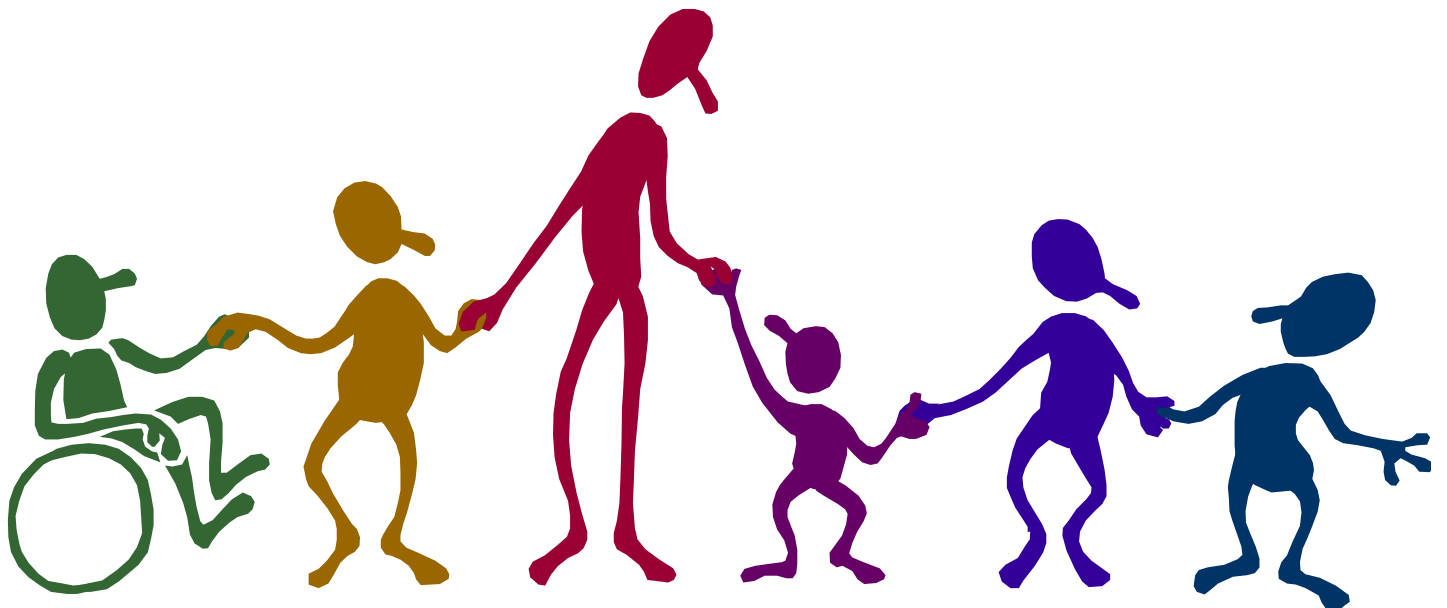
We will ask someone to decide if we have done everything fairly. This person will not know you or us or the person you think has been unfair.

When they have decided what is fair you will be told.



If you are still upset and feel things are wrong or unfair, it's ok to tell someone else. There are people who will make very sure that everything is fair.


There are people from 'Ofsted' who make sure children are treated in the right way. You can telephone them and they will listen to you.
